

## Lively Memoir outlines the life of CAPSI Chairman, Kunwar Vikram Singh

**New Delhi, December 31, 2022**-In this latest non-fiction novel, Kunwar Vikram Singh, Chairman of the Central Association of Private Security Industry (CAPSI) puts forth several captivating stories which being true experiences of his life, present a real picture of the Indian private security sector. The book was launched during CAPSI's 17<sup>th</sup> Security Leadership Summit held at New Delhi Convention Centre earlier this month. In a little more than 200 pages, Kunwar Vikram Singh describes the profound struggles of Indian security entrepreneurs including himself through both pleasant and unpleasant phases of professional life. He shows how with their true grit and determination, the private security industry (PSI) metamorphosed into a sunrise sector taking challenges head-on, with CAPSI leading the way. The institution at present is relentlessly pursuing its mission of skilling 1 crore guardsmen & women across the nation, which continues to reshape their destiny. It also gives a sneak peek into the life of security professionals whose pious love for their motherland drives them to persevere through uncertainties with bravery and fervor. It also outlines their ongoing battles with the current legislative frameworks governing the PSI.

Published by Chandigarh based White Falcon Publishing, the novel is first of its kind to be written on the Indian PSI. *"I have been associated with CAPSI for over two decades now and this is my second book about the private security industry. 'The Protectors', however, is special as it involved a greater investment in terms of time. I have spent endless hours recalling and journaling certain important events of my life. It was as if I was chosen by destiny to lead from the front. And till this day, I continue to"*, he added.
